#### **TODAY'S GOSPEL: Luke 17:1-10**

And he said to his disciples, "Temptations to sin are sure to come; but woe to him by whom they come! It would be better for him if a mill-stone were hung round his neck and he were cast into the sea, than that he should cause one of these little ones to sin. Take heed to yourselves; if your brother sins, rebuke him, and if he repents, forgive him; and if he sins against you seven times in the day, and turns to you seven times, and say, "I repent," you must forgive him."

The apostles said to the Lord, "Increase our faith!" And the Lord said, "If you had faith as a grain of mustard seed, you could say to this sycamine tree, 'Be rooted up, and be planted in the sea,' and it would obey you.

"Will any one of you, who has a servant plowing or keeping sheep, say to him when he has come in from the field, 'Come at once and sit down at table'? Will he not rather say to him, 'Prepare supper for me, and gird yourself and serve me, till I eat and drink; and afterward you shall eat and drink'? Does he thank the servant because he did what was commanded? So you also, when you have done all that is commanded you, say, 'We are unworthy servants; we have only done what was our duty.'"

## V.A. Approves Armenian Cross for Vets' Graves

The U.S. Department of Veteran Affairs recently approved the Armenian cross as an official "Emblem of Belief" to mark the graves of Armenian-American veterans. The effort was led by the family of the late Shavasp Hanesian of Niagara Falls, NY, who served in the U.S. Army during World War II. To date the Department of Veteran Affairs has approved more than 45 "Emblems of Belief." The emblems representing the religious background of the veteran are installed at grave sites by cemetery officials.
