ALL SAINTS DAY

The word *saint / soorp* means *just* and *God-pleasing*. In the early Christian centuries believers addressed each other as Saints. Saint Paul often will use this term in his many letters.

In the subsequent centuries, this exclusive term of Christian piety and goodness became reserved for those men and women of great faith who lived an exemplary and virtuous life and gave their lives in the service of Christ, demonstrating the love of God and the fellowship of the Holy Spirit by their grace-filled examples.

Many became martyred and gave their lives willingly for what they believed. They found favor with God. We thank them all for showing us through their lives how we can please God and become one with Him.

In the Armenian Church there are two categories of saints: those who are celebrated and those who are commemorated. The holy martyrs, confessors, and saints are commemorated during our liturgies throughout the year. Saints who are of great example to us have their own day[s] of celebration. There are many saints unknown to the Christian Church by name. Not everyone had a biographer to write about them and share details about their pious lives. It is for this reason that the church observes a special day called ALL SAINTS DAY, commemorating "all saints old and new, known and unknown."

Old and new refers to those saints about which we know little or nothing about having lived during the time of our Lord and in subsequent years until the present. They are the saints of the Old Testament, the holy righteous Prophets, Kings who lived good lives and who had the vision of the coming Messiah, like Isaiah, King David, King Solomon. Then there are holy people whose names were not recorded in history.

So the Feast of All Saints is a general celebration of **all** God-pleasing men and women who dedicated their lives to God and even sacrificed their lives to their last breath for the love of Christ. They do not have a special day of their own, so they are universally remembered and honored on *All Saints Day*.

For All the Saints

For all the saints whom from their labors rest, who Thee by faith before the world confessed Thy Name O Jesus, be forever blessed.

Alleluia. Alleluia.
