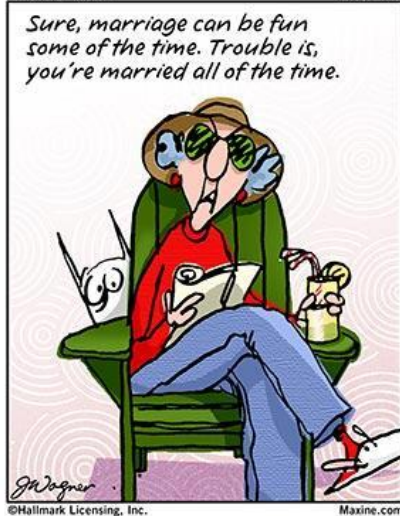
**Investing in Others**
